DET. ROMERO AND INVESTIGATOR MYERS CONTINUED INTERVIEW OF LAWRENCE NIXON. NIXON INSISTED THAT IF HE KNEW ANYTHING ABOUT THIS CRIME HE WOULD HAVE COME FORWARD AND TOLD US WHAT WE WANTED TO KNOW. INVESTIGATOR MYERS REMINDED NIXON THAT HE INITALLY LIED TO US CONCERNING ANY KNOWLEDGE OF THE CRIME AND ONLY WHEN HE WAS MADE AWARE HIS GIRLFRIEND HAD TOLD US ABOUT BYRON AND THE BLOODY SHIRT DID HE ADMIT TO ANY INVOLVEMENT AND KNOWLEDGE.

LACONIA ALSO INDICATED SHE HEARD THE STORY ABOUT THE MEXICAN'S AND MARIE AROUND THE "CHING'S" GROCERY WHICH IS SAN FRANCISCO GROCERY ON MAIN STREET.

LACONIA WAS SHOWN A PICTURE OF BYRON CHAD JONES SHE INDICATED SHE HAD SEEN HIM AROUND JENNINGS BUT COULD NOT RECALL SEEING BYRON AROUND LARRY WEST'S HOUSE OR WITH LAWRENCE NIXON.
